Kaleidoscopes

A full day – 10 am to 4 pm – workshop designed to cover the basics of mirror construction, chamber building, And eye piece construction as well as using various materials to finish the exterior of your scope.

Fee: \$75.00 plus a materials fee of \$25.00 First grade quality front surface mirror will be used for your scope. Exterior coverings can be fabric, leather, paper with various embellishments. You will have various choices here.

Cement Garden Art

A full day – 10 am to 4 pm – workshop. You will end the day with one of the following:

1. a large planter or bowl
2. a garden ball on a pedestal
3. a sculpture of your own design using armature wire or other armature materials

Due to the length of time for the cement to set, please be prepared to take your work home on a board that will be supplied as part of the materials fee, and it will need to cure for at least a week. Finishing techniques will be discussed for you to complete when the work has cured.

Fee: \$75.00 plus a materials fee of \$15.00

Papermaking Workshop

A full day – 10 am to 4 pm – workshop.

Learn to make your own paper that you can use for journal making or a diary or scrapbook. You can also use your handmade paper for drawing and painting, making your own cards or for embellishments on note cards or letters, scrapbook pages or on gift wrapping, among many other uses which will be discussed during the workshop.

Fee: \$75.00 plus a materials fee of \$10.00
