**FREE MORNING PROGRAMS** (10 to 11:30 a.m.) – free with a park day or annual pass. Children must be accompanied by an adult for all morning programs. Meet at the Interpretive Centre unless otherwise specified.

**FULL DAY PROGRAMS** – The cost for these full care programs is \$35 per child and \$30 for an additional family member registered in the same session. Programs are for children aged 6 – 12 and run from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Pre-registration is required. A maximum of 20 children will be accepted to maintain a ratio of one instructor for every 10 children.
